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There is a Salah between the two Adhans

The fifth question of Fatwa no. 8250

Q: I heard that Tahiyat-ul-Masjid (two-unit-Prayer to greet the mosque) should not be performed after Adhan (call for prayer), because Salah during that time is an act of Sunnah. What is the degree of authenticity of this opinion?

A: It is an act of Sunnah to offer two Rak`ahs between every Adhan and Iqamah (call to start the Prayer) because it was reported that the Prophet (peace be upon him) said, [There is a prayer between the two Adhans \(Adhan and Iqamah\), there is a prayer between the two Adhans.](#) And then while saying it the third time he added: [For the one who wants to \(pray\).](#) These prayers include the supererogatory Salah and the Sunnah of the Fajr (Dawn) Salah. When a person enters the Masjid (mosque) to offer the supererogatory Salah of Zhuhr (Noon) or Fajr (Dawn) Salah, it will suffice for the Salah of Tahiyat-ul-Masjid.
