



Women Offering Salah in the Presence of Men

Fatwa no. (13452):

Q: How does a woman offer Salah (Prayer) if there are Ajanib (men lawful for the woman to marry) present in the place, such as in Al-Masjid Al-Haram? What should she do if she is traveling and there is no Masjid (mosque) on the road where there is a Musalla (a place for Prayer) for women?

A: A woman should cover all her body while she is offering Salah, except her face and hands. However, if she offers Salah in the presence of Ajanib, she should cover all her body, including her face and hands.
