



Changing one's intention from Zuhra to 'Asr prayer during prayer

Fatwa no. 12673

Q: While I was offering the Zuhra (Noon) Prayer with the Imam in the Masjid (mosque), I remembered that I had already performed Zuhra and that it was time for 'Asr. I had entered into the prayer with the intention of praying Zuhra. Shall I change my intention for 'Asr (during Salah) or should I leave the Salah to change my intention?

A: If the situation is as you have mentioned, then you should leave the Zuhra Prayer and resume Salah with the Imam whenever you remember. When the Imam concludes the Salah, you have to make up for the missed Rak'ahs of 'Asr Prayer.
