Impermissibility of being absent or late for work without a valid excuse

Fatwa no. 10729:

Q: I am a government employee whose working hours are from 5 to 11 in the afternoon and as everyone knows, my salary is very minimal. That is why I have another job and I only go to my government job from 6 to 6:30 but I do everything that is asked of me perfectly. My question now is: Is it Haram (prohibited) to spend the time of my government job doing something else, as my boss tells me? Is the salary I get Haram as well and has no blessing from Allah? I hope you will answer me regarding this sensitive issue, as I am confused and I fear to be receiving an unlawful minimal salary. Bear in mind that I do my job and the other one as well.

A: You should be present at your work during the official working hours and you cannot leave without taking the permission of your boss in agreement with the system. May Allah grant us success! May peace and blessings be upon our Prophet Muhammad, his family and Companions!
